PLENARY INDULGENCE

The Apostolic Penitentiary, by mandate of the Supreme Pontiff, grants a Plenary Indulgence to the Faithful who, whilst devoutly visiting the Holy House, fulfil the necessary conditions: Prayer for the Pope's intentions, Sacramental Confession and Holy Communion, which may also be fulfilled on the days immediately preceding or following the visit, and a disposition of mind that excludes all attachment to sin, even venial:

On the Solemnities of the Blessed Virgin Mary

- Most Holy Mother of God – 1 January;
- Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary – 15 August;
- Immaculate Conception – 8 December.

On the Solemnities proper to the Shrine and the Holy Family

- Annunciation of the Lord – 25 March;
- Nativity of the Blessed Virgin – 8 September;
- Our Lady of Loreto – Transfer of the Holy House – 10 December;
- Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph;
- Solemnity of St Joseph – 19 March.

On other occasions and circumstances

- Holy Apostles Peter and Paul - 29 June;
- Personal pilgrimage: once a year, on a day freely chosen by the faithful;
- Group pilgrimages: whenever the faithful visit in an organised group to venerate the Holy House.
